CHICAGO ROUND -TRIP

Lakes and Falls

Driving Distance: 1200 Miles Driving Time: 30 Hours Recommended Trip: 14 Days

Day 1	Fly into Chicago. Spend the first night in an hotel in the Chicago area.
Day 2	The morning is free to explore Chicago. In the afternoon you will pickup the motor home at the rental station. You then can drive to the Elkhart, Indiana KOA.
Day 3	Spend the day in the Elkhart area. The campground has a heated swimming pool, a petting zoo, and miniature golf. A golf course is nearby, there are hiking trails at the campground, or you can take short visit to the nearby Amish area. They have beautiful farms, cheese factories, and restaurants nearby.
Day 4	Today you will drive about three hours from Elkhart, Indiana to Detroit, Michigan. You have a choice of taking the toll way through Indiana and Ohio north to Detroit, or from the KOA kampground drive north to Kalamazoo, Michigan, and across i-94 through Battle Creek, home of Kellogg cereals. Stop there and visit the cereal factories, and then on into the Detroit/Greenfield KOA.
Day 5	Spend the day in the Detroit area. Drive over to Greenfield village, see the henry ford museum. Spend a second night at the Detroit/Greenfield KOA.
Day 6	A leisurely drive from Greenfield village north to the Port Huron, Michigan KOA. It will be approximately a one and a half to two hour drive. This KOA is a complete camping resort. It is located on 55 acres of land with many activities on the campground.
Day 7-8	The campground is located next to the Canadian border. It is close to some boating areas, fishing, large shopping malls, and many activities, or just simply lay back and enjoy the quiet camping environment.
Day 9	Today you will travel along the Canadian highway to Niagara Falls, Ontario. It is approximately a four hour drive, so either linger at Port Huron before you leave, or stop along the way at some of the Canadian cities like London, Brantford, or Hamilton. Arrive at Niagara Falls sometime in the afternoon.
Day 10	Today you will explore the world famous Niagara Falls, and the many attractions in the area. You can take a half day tour from the campground of all the major attractions. Marine land is nearby, a giant waterslide, and many others.
Day 11	Cross the border once again into New York and proceed along the shores of Lake

Erie to Erie, Pennsylvania KOA. Since it is only about a three hour drive you can enjoy Niagara Falls before you leave, or drive to Erie and enjoy the beautiful Erie

KOA. Enjoy the fishing, pool and other campground amenities, or if you rather you can go to the nearby shopping malls, visit some wineries, or some of the other historic sites.

- Day 12 Drive along the south shore of Lake Erie passing through Cleveland, Ohio and on into Toledo, Ohio. Today is a short drive of about three hours allowing plenty of time to stop along the way, and visit some of the cities and towns in Ohio.
- Day 13 From Toledo continue heading west to South Bend, Indiana. Once again you have a choice of traveling on the interstate and the toll roads, or taking the back roads and seeing some of the beautiful farm country. Stop in some of the little stores. This is your last chance to enjoy some of the Amish crafts, quilts, and cheese factories. In South Bend allow enough time to unpack your motor home and get things ready for your trip home.
- Day 14 Return to the rental center in Chicago, turn in your motor home and have a safe journey home.
