Seattle Round-Trip

Washington Highlights

Driving Distance: 600 Miles Driving Time: 15 Hours Recommended Trip: 7 Days

- Day 1 Fly into Seattle, Washington, and check into a downtown hotel.
- Day 2 Take this morning to explore Seattle. In the afternoon you will pick up a motorhome, and drive to Leavenworth, Washington. This route will be over highway 2, over Stevens Pass, through the Wenatchee mountains. Check into a KOA site and park your motorhome.
- Day 3 Today you will have a full day to explore the Leavenworth area. Leavenworth, Washington, is famous for its European Bavarian style village. There are great places to hike, golf, and fish in the area as well as rafting on the river. Enjoy the hot spa or the 80 degree swimming pool at the campground, and enjoy the cool nights, or take a walk on the sandy beach at the nearby Wenatchee River.
- Day 4 Take a leisurely drive from Leavenworth down to Wenatchee, Washington, and then north along highway 97 and 153 to the KOA in Winthrop, Washington. Today's drive will take you through the heart of some beautiful apple orchard. You have plenty of time today to stop and view the Columbia River or even take a walk in the Okanogan National Forest. The campground has a heated pool, volleyball, horseshoes, and a playground. Near the campground are golf courses, horseback riding, and rafting.
- Day 5 Spend the full day enjoying the attractions of the Winthrop area. Winthrop is a unique western town with wooden boardwalks around the town with many stores selling western art, antiques, and western wear.
- Day 6 From Winthrop drive through the north Cascades National Park. You have plenty of time today to stop along the route. Enjoy some hiking side trips, or stopping at the overlooks on the Ross Lake.
- Day 7 Drive back to Seattle, turn in your motor home and have a safe journey home.
