

ATLANTA ROUND-TRIP

Musical Pleasures

Driving distance: Approx 1100 driving miles

Driving time: 20 hours approx

Recommended trip: 8 days

Day 1 Atlanta to Chattanooga (116 miles) pick up your motorhome and head northwest to see if you can find that Chattanooga Choo Choo! You will be on the freeway and pass alongside Chattanooga National Park.

Day 2 Chattanooga to Pigeon Forge (142 miles) Here is Dollywood, so for Dolly Parton fans consider yourself now officially in heaven! Apart from that, nearby you can visit 'Ripley's Believe or Not' and the 'Guinness Book of Records'.

Day 3/4 Pigeon Forge to Nashville (228 miles) The home of Country Music where, if the Grand Old Opry doesn't appeal, two days relaxing in the bars, listening to the music and seeing the shows should be very satisfying.

Day 5/6 Nashville to Memphis (204 miles) This is just the place for the fans of The King – the great Elvis Presley. Graceland, his home, is just 30 miles from the Memphis East KOA so you can visit while in town and again on the way out!

Day 7 Memphis to Birmingham (288 miles) The homeward run but worth the stop in Birmingham. En route, visit Natchez Trace and the Tupelo National Battlefield for a little bit of history. In Birmingham visit the Arlington Anti Bellum Home to see what life was like in the deep south.

Day 8 Birmingham to Atlanta (165 miles) Your motorhome probably needs to be back in Atlanta by 11am (unless you bought the Early Bird Special which means a relaxed return by 3pm) so it will be quite an early start.
