

SEATTLE ROUND-TRIP

Pacific North West

Driving Distance: 2300 Driving Miles

Driving Time: 58 Hours Approx

Recommended Trip: 17 Days

- Day 1 Arrive in Seattle and check into an hotel You will spend two nights in the 'Emerald City' whose landmark, the Space Needle is easily recognisable, towering 605 ft above the city.
- Day 2 Pick up your motorhome and enjoy a full day at leisure to explore the city of Seattle, a city on Puget Sound between the Olympic Mountains and the Cascade Mountains. Take time to visit the Space Needle, Pioneer Square and Pike Place Market as well as the beautiful waterfront parks.
- Day 3 Pick up your hire car today and head north to Canada. Spend two nights in Vancouver, British Columbia, the major Canadian city on the West Coast, located across from Victoria on Vancouver Island, a charming community reachable by a ferry cruising through the islands dotting the Strait of Georgia.
- Day 4 Enjoy a full day to explore Vancouver situated like a jewel on the Pacific. Include a visit to Chinatown, Robson Street, Stanley Park and Gastown, which was the site of Vancouver's humble origins as a lumber town.
- Day 5 Drive through major cattle ranching and nickel mining areas along the Coquihalla Highway to Kamloops in the interior of British Columbia.
- Day 6 See the breathtaking splendour of Canada's National Park as you travel to Jasper, in Jasper National Park, offering spectacular views of the Rocky Mountain wilderness.
- Day 7 At leisure in Jasper to visit the beautiful glacier fed Maligne Lake. Try white-water rafting, explore the surrounding lakes and mountains or try horse-riding.
- Day 8 Travel along the Icefields Parkway and see the glaciers of Columbia Icefield, maybe take a trip onto the Athabasca Glacier by snowmobile. Continue to Lake Louise and view the glacier-fed, blue-green lake of the same name.

- Day 9 Day to relax in Canada's first National Park in this thriving year-round resort with its charming shops and dining spots.
- Day 10 Head south today to Glacier/Waterton Lakes National Park, the first park shared by the USA and Canada.
- Day 11 Crossing back into the United States you will travel along the glorious Going-to-the-Sun Road in Glacier National Park. See for yourself why Montana is called the 'Big Sky Country' as you drive through this typical Western countryside where the Buffalo once roamed.
- Day 12 A full day's drive through some spectacular scenery towards Yellowstone National Park, home of Old Faithful. Your overnight hotel is located near the entrance to the park.
- Day 13 The diversity of wildlife is only equalled by the geological wonders of America's first national park. Enjoy the geysers and the bison during your tour of this national treasure.
- Day 14 Start your journey westward back to the Pacific Ocean to Missoula, a peaceful college city.
- Day 15 Continue your westward journey through the dramatic scenery of northern Montana and Idaho to arrive in Spokane, the second largest city in Washington State.
- Day 16 Travel through lush valleys and heavily wooded apple orchards to Seattle.
- Day 17 Return your motorhome today and have a safe journey home.
